MANAGERS' INFORMATION

Location: All Match Days will be held at the Christchurch Netball Centre at Nga Puna Wai, Augustine Drive, Aidanfield, Christchurch.

Meet and Greet Dinner Expect an entertaining evening with Entertainment, an Inspirational Speaker and Team Acts from all groups.

Enter with your group so we can check numbers when you arrive

Local registered teams are invited as part of the registration at 6.45pm to attend the Opening Ceremony and Meet and Greet evening entertainment. **OPTION:** if you wish to join the international teams for dinner, there is a small cost which must be paid before the festival.

Opening Ceremony: 8.15am This will be held at the netball courts. All teams will line up at the far end of the courts for an epic parade! This is your moment to shine, show your team spirit, and be welcomed in a fun and festive celebration. Let's start this event with energy, excitement, and a whole lot of team spirit!

Managers' Meeting will be held on Match Day 1 as per draw. The umpires' meeting will follow.

Manager Bag: Teams that have booked a tour package with INF only, will be given manager bags at the Meet and Greet dinner.

Lunches on Match Days for players that have ordered and paid as part of the tour package will be available from the officials desk. Only two people from your team are required to collect the lunches. We will announce when they arrive and will ask one group to collect them at a time. Your teams 2 representatives will sign for the number of lunches received that have been prepaid.

First Aid: First aid available onsite for the duration of netball games on the three game days.

MANAGERS' INFORMATION

Action Photos: Please see Manager's information for your group photo time (prepaid teams). The photographer will contact all teams directly and meet you at the court. The photographer will take a casual team photograph and 20 minutes of action shots. Each team will receive a team photo at the Festival Dinner and players will be able to download the photos after the Festival.

All **local teams are welcome to book action photography**, if the photographer has availability.

Clean Up: All teams will be given a rubbish bag each day. Please be respectful and if you see rubbish, pick it up and pop it in the bag or a rubbish bin.

Awards Presentation will be held immediately after the finals. All participants will receive a participation award if they have not won the 1st, 2nd or 3rd awards.

Festival Final Dinner will be held at Nga Hau E Whaa Marae, 250 Pages Road, Wainoni— arrive at 6.00pm. We will have a group photo upon arrival. The evening includes dinner, farewells and a cultural performance. Locals and visitors are invited and must pay prior.

Insurance: Travelling teams have been offered Travel Insurance prior to leaving their home town. Local teams should ensure that their Clubs or individual private insurance will cover you in case of injury. Players play at their own risk.

COMPETITION RULES

Registration

A player must be registered and paid for, to play in the International Netball Festival BEFORE TAKING TO THE COURT and team names , DOB required.

Playing in a Division

Players are not permitted to play down or across a Division. Once a player has played up for two games they will then be part of this team. They cannot play down again. All 1,2,3 placing teams' players must sign in at the Control Desk on Finals Day. New players will not be allowed to join a team on the Finals Day. Boys (13 years or under) can play in the 13/U Division only. There can only be three (3) boys on the court at any one time in a team—one boy in each third of the court.

Playing in more than one team

Players are not permitted to play in more than one team. Once players are registered in a team, they must stay in that team. If there are injuries and one team does not have enough players and wishes to pull a player from another team across the division, we will assess this at the time.

Scorecards and Points

Umpires only must collect scorecards from the umpire office. A scorer from each team must be supplied. Scorers must stand beside each other on the sideline. Scoresheets only are to be returned to the INF Control Desk by the winning team. Please have teams fill in Umpires award on the scorecard. Umpires need to sign and fill in points for the Team Sportsmanship Award. Points Table will be positioned at the clubhouse. It will be posted on the INF Facebook Page and website each evening.

Stoppages

Blood Policy Play shall cease immediately when blood is noticed. The player must leave the court immediately and may be replaced. The injured player may return to the court at the next centre pass if the blood flow has ceased, the wound cleaned and covered. If a shooter or centre is injured, the team may change one other player on the court to take that position. Stoppages are to be kept to a minimum.

COMPETITION RULES

Stoppages Continued..

Injuries There will be 30 seconds for minor injury. The player may be replaced. If a shooter or centre is injured, the team may change one other player on the court to take that position. Stoppages are to be kept to a minimum. They may re-enter the court after the next centre pass off, if they have not been replaced.

Send Off If someone has been sent off the court, they have to be off the court for a minimum of 2 minutes. They can go back on the court after 2 minutes, at the next centre pass off.

Wet Weather The Festival is being held at the beautiful indoor centre in Christchurch.

COMPETITION POINTS

Three (3) points for a win, two (2) points for a draw and one (1) point for a loss.

Tie in Competition Points

If there is a tie with competition points at the end of competition, the team's placing in the ladder will be determined by the following, in this order:

1. The result of the game between the 2 teams – if that was a draw then,
2. A count back of goal difference - Goals For vs Goals Against. The team with the biggest goal difference will qualify ahead in the ladder – if this was equal then,
3. Fair play points as awarded by the umpires – if this is equal then,
4. A toss of the coin by the Tournament Director with the 2 team captains. (The team who has travelled furthest to the Festival will call the toss)

Draw at the End of a Final

The teams are allowed a 1 minute drinks break at the full time whistle. NO players can be changed. There will be three (3) minutes extra time each way. No break. If it is still a draw then it will be first team to reach a two (2) goal lead. NO change of players, no breaks.



TEAM ACTS

Each team is encouraged to create a Team Act to perform at the **Meet and Greet**. It's a lot of fun and a great laugh.

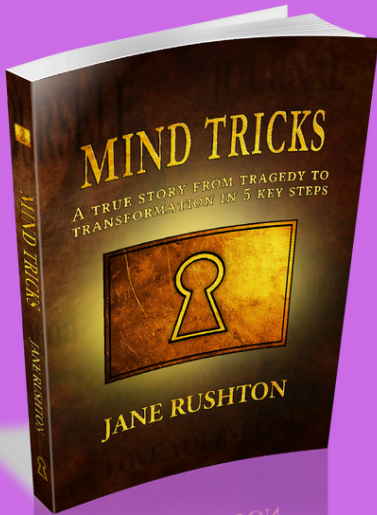
YOUR thoughts, affect moods, situations and behaviours. By using Jane's method, players will work together as a team, and better with coaches or anyone in their life.

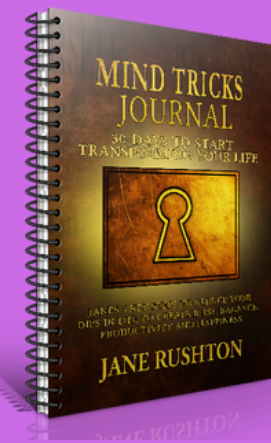
